Your examination fee will be paid online to Kryterion, once your examination application has been reviewed and approved by the NDBACE.

Eligibility Requirements:

All academic coursework must be completed before you will be approved to sit for the National Addiction Counselor, level I (NCAC I) examination. You must have your transcripts sent from the college or university directly to the NDBACE office if you have not done so already. The exam is administered by the National Certification Commission for Addiction Professionals (NCCA AP), which is the credentialing arm of the National Association for Addiction Professionals (NAADAC).

Examination Sites:

At this time, testing is being done at Minot State University, Tuesday – Friday with times varying based upon availability. Testing is also available in Fargo on Thursdays. Additional sites within the state will be available in the future and those will be posted as they become available.

Examination Date Registration:

- Once the NDBACE grants examination approval, you will receive an email message from the exam administrator containing information about how to register for an examination date, time, and location.
- Length of time to receive approval ranges from one week (if all your academic coursework was previously verified by NDBACE as complete) to several weeks (if you are submitting your academic coursework for review with your examination application).
- If you don't receive an email message from the examination administrator after the suggested amount of time, please contact the NDBACE office.
- **You must bring a copy of the email with you to your exam.**

The NDBACE receives email notices with exam scores every two weeks. You will be notified by email once we receive your score.
